NORMS FOR THE PRESENTATION OF MANUSCRIPTS

Author's name	The name of the author(s) must figure as the author wishes it to be published.
ORCID	The ORCiD number of each author must be informed.
Length of the title and subtitle	Article's titles and subtitles cannot exceed 80 characters with spaces.
Length of the abstract	All texts, except reviews, must be accompanied by an abstract in English containing a maximum of 800 characters with spaces, with objective, method, results and conclusions of the article. The spacing must be 1.5 between the lines and without spaces between paragraphs, not containing abbreviations or references and bringing the title of the paper at the beginning.
Keywords	At the end of the abstracts, a maximum of four keywords (descriptors) of the text content should be indicated, which must be searched in the Thesaurus or in the European Education Thesaurus .
Sheet size	A4
Margins	2.54 cm in all margins
Font	Times New Roman
Font size	Size 12
Spacing	Line spacing of 1.5. No spacing (before or after) between paragraphs.
Number of characters	Articles, theoretical essays and experience reports should have a minimum length of 35,000 characters with spaces, and cannot exceed 63,300 characters with spaces, including tables, graphs, charts or figures, annexes or appendices and references. The maximum length of the Review is 14,550 characters with spaces.
Acronyms and abbreviations	The acronyms should be extended when first mentioned in the article. E.g.: Ministério da Educação (MEC). Pronounceable acronyms with more than three letters must be written in upper and lower case. E.g.: Exame Nacional do Ensino Médio (Enem).

Footnotes	The footnotes must be avoided and only used when strictly necessary, preferably without exceeding three lines. Consecutive numbering of the footnotes will be used within the text. Do not use <i>idem</i> , <i>ibidem</i> or <i>id</i> .
Tables and figures	The text's illustrations should be classified into tables and figures only. Tables comprehend tables and charts, regardless of the nature of the illustrated information (quantitative or qualitative). In turn, figures comprehend images, graphs, maps, etc. All illustrations should be in editable format in the Word file. The figures, besides being contained in the article, must be uploaded in separate files, as supplementary documents, with a resolution of at least 300 DPIs, in JPG or PNG format. All tables and figures must be numbered with Arabic numerals, with titles (positioned above) standardized as to the format and terms used. Below these, the source of the data (referring to the bibliographic references) must be indicated, with authorship and year, even if it is the authors' own preparation (Source: Prepared by the authors). In the PDF file, tables and figures must be inserted in the position where they will be published.
Statistical methodology	The statistical methodology used must be described in a level of detail that allows the results to be replicated by a reader with experience in the subject who has access to the original data. On the other hand, the use of an excessively technical language must be avoided, in order to present the methodological description with sufficient clarity so that a non-specialized reader can also understand it. These recommendations are mainly translated into measures such as: • providing details on experimental units, randomization and sampling procedures; • describing and/or providing access to the research collecting instruments; • indicating all the descriptive and inferential techniques used, providing bibliographic references whenever necessary; • presenting the quantitative results with their respective uncertainty measures (confidence intervals, p-values, etc.); • adopting a level of precision in the presentation of data and results (e.g. number of decimal places) that is standardized and consistent with the possibilities of the research; • using graphic resources and tables whenever these elements can facilitate the organization and synthesis of data and the understanding of the results; • discussing the reasonableness of the obtained results and report possible limitations of the methods used; • defining technical terms, mathematical symbols and acronyms in the article; • specifying the statistical software used.
In-text citation	Short literal quotations, with up to 40 words, must be integrated into the text, between double quotation marks, followed by parentheses with the author's last name, in upper and lower case, with year of publication and page number. Quotations with more than 40 words must be presented in a separate paragraph, with a half-inch indentation from the left margin, 1.5 spacing and size 12 font. References without literal quotation must be incorporated into the text, without page information. Do not use <i>idem</i> , <i>ibidem</i> , or <i>op. cit</i> . References	References, restricted only to the works cited in the text, must come at the end of the text, according to the 7 th edition of the <i>Publication manual of the American Psychological Association</i> (APA), and follow the alphabetical order of the first author's last name, with 1.5 spacing and a half-inch indentation starting from the second line. Note on authorship	A note must be included at the end of texts with four or more authors, stating the participation of each one in the preparation of the article.
Anonymity	Authors should remove any information that identifies them, indicating XXX in citation references, funding, bibliography, projects, reports, etc. Example: (XXX, 2023).
